Khokhloma painting

Khokhloma painting is

Khokhloma painting is an ancient Russian folk craft that appeared in the XVII century in the village of Khokhloma. It is a decorative painting of wooden dishes and furniture, made in red, green and gold tones on a black background.



Why Khokhloma painting is often called "Wooden gold"?

The answer is simple
Khokhloma tableware
is varnished, which
gives it a matte shine.
Because of the
abundance of yellow
and orange colors in
the painting,
Khokhloma dishes
were called wooden
gold



Colors that are used in Khokhloma painting

The main colors were black and red, and later other shades were used. Painted products were varnished and tempered in a furnace. This is how "wooden gold" was made.

Other central colors of the palette are black and red. It was possible to add completeness and versatility to the drawing by using white and ochre.
